

Terms & Conditions for the Energy Locals Free Solar System Competition (in association with Brisbane Heat) NSW Permit Number LTPS/19/31022

1. Entrants to the Competition are taken to accept and agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
2. The Promoter of the Competition is Energy Locals Pty Ltd, 132 Cremorne Street Richmond 3121 (ABN 23 606 408 879) (Promoter).
3. The Competition commences at 08:00 (AEST) on 19th December 2018 and closes at 11:59pm on 30th March 2019. (Competition Period)
4. Entry into (and winning) this Competition is only open to individuals who:
 - a. are a resident of Queensland or New South Wales
 - b. are aged eighteen (18) years or older as at the time of entry into the Competition; and
5. **Minor prize ONLY**
 - a. have completed and submitted the online form with their personal information and agreed to the terms of the Privacy Policy and these Terms and Conditions; and
 - b. Has not won a previous minor prize from this competition
6.
 - a. **Major Prize ONLY:** have completed a quote with Energy Locals online or over the phone with an Energy Locals representative and as a result have changed their residential electricity to Energy Locals from another electricity retailer; and
 - b. are the account holder of an active and fully paid Energy Locals residential account as at the date of the Draw, (Eligible Entrant) or
 - c. Has switched to Energy locals and is pending activation of Electricity service or;
 - d. Is an Energy Locals customer and has an active, fully paid electricity service on the date of the draw
7. An Eligible Entrant excludes any:
 - a. employee or agent of the Promoter including consultants or contractors;
 - b. relative of an employee of the Promoter, being a spouse, parent, step-parent, sibling or child of that employee;
 - c. Energy Locals customer who has cancelled their Energy Locals electricity account or whose supply of electricity has been cancelled by either the customer or Energy Locals as at the date of the Draw;
 - d. Energy Locals customer who has an overdue account balance at any time during the Competition Period.
8. Energy Locals reserves the right to add means of entry into the competition throughout the competition period and to automatically enter existing customers to any of the minor or major prize draws.
9. **Minor Prize:**

- a. To enter the Competition, Eligible Entrants must complete the registration form located at energylocals.com.au/heat and submit online between 12pm on home game day and 12pm the following home game day, for the first 2 Brisbane Heat home games as outlined below.
- b. To be eligible for the 3rd Minor Prize draw, eligible entrants must complete the registration form between 12pm on Tuesday 1st January and March 30th 2019. Minor prize winners will be drawn within 10 business days of the closure of each minor draw.
- c. Entrants may participate in multiple competitions by registering in each of the 4 minor prize draws during the competition period.

- d. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected entries due to technical disruptions, network congestions or any other reason. Only one entry is allowed per household.
- e. Eligible Entrants must provide a valid email address, phone number and postcode.
- f. The draw will take place by random digital selection at 132 Cremorne Street Richmond 3121, and the winners will be notified by the email address provided.
- g. Each minor prize winner will receive 12 calendar months of Free 100% Renewable Electricity provided by Energy Locals.
- h. The Prize will be awarded by applying a credit on the winner's account each month or quarter for 12 corresponding months or 4 quarters. The maximum value of each prize will be \$2500 over the 12 month period.
- i. The Prize is not transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash.
- j. In the event that the winner of the Prize does not hold a current electricity account with Energy Locals, the winner will be required to switch their residential energy supplier to Energy Locals in order to redeem their prize.
- k. In the event that the winner holds an existing Energy Locals account at the time of the draw, previous billing periods will be required to be paid in full prior to redemption of the prize.

7. Major Prize Draw:

- a. To enter the Competition, Eligible Entrants must sign-up to an eligible Energy Locals residential Electricity service prior to the competition end date, no later than 23:59pm March 30th 2019.
 - b. Entries received after this time will automatically be deemed as invalid. The time of the entry will be the time the entry is received by the Promoter's database. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected entries due to technical disruptions, network congestions or any other reason. Only one entry is allowed per residential address.
 - c. Eligible Entrants must reside in south east Queensland or New South Whales in an area serviceable by Energy Locals.
 - d. The draw will take place by random digital selection at 12:00pm on Monday 8th April 2019 at 132 Cremorne Street Richmond 3121, and the winners will be notified by the email address provided with 48 hours of completion of the draw and via telephone.
 - e. The first valid entry drawn will receive:
 - i. A fully-installed 5kW home solar PV system;
 - ii. A fully-installed Tesla Powerwall;
 - iii. Prize value is estimated at \$20,000 but will be subject to specifications at the residence.
 - f. The Prize is not transferable
 - g. Where the winning entrant's property does not meet requirements for a solar system installation, the winner will be eligible to accept a cash prize valued at \$15,000 in place of the solar system.
 - i. A property inspection will be required to determine suitability to install a solar system at the winner's residence
 - ii. The inspection will be carried out by a certified technician supplied by Energy Locals.
 - iii. Apartment building and multi-dwelling units will be automatically ineligible for the prize
 - h. In the event that the Prize winner's Energy Locals electricity account is disconnected or cancelled prior to redemption date, the prize will be forfeited.
8. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to request proof of the validity of entries and Eligible Entrants (including an entrant's identity, age, place of residence or relationship to an employee of the Promoter) to claim a Prize and to disqualify any entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or an entrant who tampers with the entry process. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

9. The Promoter will endeavor to notify the winners in writing by email (and may also notify by telephone) within two weeks of the Draw. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for failure to notify a winner if that winner is not reasonably contactable. The Prize must be claimed within 28 days of the Draw.
10. In the event of an unclaimed prize 28 days prior to the draw, Energy Locals will redraw at midday the following day.
11. The Promoter's decision regarding the Draw, determination of the winner and the conduct of the Competition is final and cannot be contested. No correspondence shall be entered into.
